Program Overview:

The Saint Francis Community Services Alcohol & Drug Treatment Program offers a resource for women who are either pregnant or have children and utilizes a gender specific treatment approach when working with women who use/abuse substances. This program:

- Creates an environment based on safety, respect, and dignity.
- Utilizes material that enhances knowledge of self, relationships, and spirituality.
- Helps women recognize and develop healthy connections to children, family, significant others, and the community.
- Provides women with opportunities to improve their socioeconomic conditions.
- Addresses women's substance abuse and culturally relevant services such as—assessments, referral systems, support groups, and individual support systems.
- Connects women with a support network of collaborative community services.



The Saint Francis Alcohol and Drug Treatment Program uses a gender-specific treatment approach that serves as its guiding principles.

Assessment & Treatment:

The SFCS Alcohol and Drug Treatment Program focuses on a gender-specific approach that identifies connections and relationships as the guiding principles of growth for women.

Through an initial assessment, Saint Francis Community Services helps develop effective substance abuse treatment programs for the mother that will allow her to begin to heal.
